Prayer Ministry

Some years ago the Lord led Dr. Kelly to open the doors of St. Paul daily for prayer. Today our prayer ministry is still full of God's presence. St. Paul has prayer Monday thru Friday at 9 a.m., and 6:30 p.m. in the sanctuary.

Home & Foreign Mission

Street Ministry

The Annual Tent Revival Crusade is held annually in the month of June or July. Men Ministry & Evangelism Department ministers from door to door.

Tuesday Night Service

Women Bible Study & Youth Ministry are held every Tuesday evening at St. Paul beginning at 6:00 p.m. Classes are taught at every level. Pastoral Ministry is also held at 7:00 p.m. Bible Study is invaluable.

Onesimus House

This is a re-entry house for ex-offenders, and it opened in 2004.

Men's Department

This is a ministry designed to promote fellowship, maturation, better health, community involvement, leadership, and outreach among men. All men are welcome to participate.

High School Ministry (SPYES)

Enrichment, guidance, leadership, and encouragement offered to students of the congregation.

Youth Department

The Youth Department is where young people of all ages come and learn the Word of God on their level. Great stress is laid upon developing a relationship with Christ through prayer, reading Scripture and teaching about the love of Christ, and life issues.

Community Resource

Center
